YOUTH EMPLOYMENT

- Provide work experience (particularly digital or engineering T-Level students)





EDUCATION PROGRAMMES

We work collaboratively with city partners and employers to deliver a range of inspiring programmes that enable residents of all ages to explore their future, develop their skills and stay connected to Portsmouth's diverse labour market. We recognise that learning, developing skills and enhancing your employability is a lifelong endeavour that every member of our community should be supported in.

APPRENTICESHIP BUS



Every year, the Apprenticeship Bus embarks on a three-day roadshow across the city of Portsmouth, bringing apprentices from local businesses and organisations directly to senior schools.

How you can get involved:

- Provide apprentices for the bus tour or our apprenticeship fair event
- Provide apprentices for interview / media work by us to promote apprentice opportunities.
- Sponsorship – merchandise, marketing, wrap of bus and lunches on tour.

EXPLORE YOUR FUTURE



Supporting students from years 9 to 11, to better understand the world of work and the local labour market, providing an early employer intervention for students to encourage career conversations and support improved student aspirations.

How you can get involved:

- Provide an EYF classroom session, business briefing session or assembly you can deliver (with support from us) in a school.

SHAPED BY SOLENT



Bringing together Solent Academies Trust, Shaping Portsmouth and a range of high-profile businesses to mentor and provide experience in business and public speaking to classes of Special Education Needs and Disability (SEND) students.

How you can get involved:

- Identify team mentor within your organisation that can mentor a team of special educational needs students (1 to 2 hour per week for 4 weeks and a few ad hoc commitments – site trip of your premises, our conference etc).
- Sponsor Shaped by Solent programme, or our Shaped by Solent shop at conference.





COMMUNITY PROGRAMMES

We are uniquely positioned to focus our energy on emerging areas of concern, whilst providing three key programmes that showcase the best of what Portsmouth has to offer. Through the resources of our Patrons and Partners, and the willingness of our volunteers, we aim to give every Portsmouth resident the chance to give back to the city that they call home.

ARMED FORCES COMMUNITY



Fostering a supportive and inclusive environment for all members of the Armed Forces Community. This includes serving personnel, reservists, veterans, spouses, children, and extended families, recognizing the essential role they play in our society.

How you can get involved:

- Identify veterans or members of the Armed Forces Community (partners, spouses, children, etc) linked to your business - to provide support as per covenant or link into our programme.
- Sign the Covenant & register for Bronze Employer Recognition Scheme (ERS), or move up to Silver or Gold Level.
- Sponsor a Shaping Portsmouth AFC event or the AFC Award.

CHARITY SUPPORT NETWORK



Our goal is to provide Portsmouth's charities and not-for-profits in need with resources and committed individuals strengthening their missions. Together we offer assistance in connecting them with the tools they need as well as passionate individuals who can make a difference in the community.

How you can get involved:

- Provide an emergency service to a charity if needed (repairs etc) – join a register of services that can be provided.
- Respond to other asks for support from charities.
- Volunteer as a charity trustee (always lots of vacancies in the city).

CHOOSE EMPLOYABILITY



Supporting each client in creating their tailored pathway to employability. Clients include Care Leavers, Homeless & Rough Sleepers and the Probation Service. We're working with our business partnerships and local education providers to create new opportunities in training and employment through apprenticeships and more.

How you can get involved:

- Provide any of our client groups with work trials (unpaid work opportunities).
- Provide supported internships or apprenticeships to SEN client groups support can be provided.
- Ring fence work trial or paid opportunities for Care Leavers. Support to be care leaver ready can be provided by us.

Enlisting passionate Portsmouth citizens as dedicated volunteers supporting and engaging with local businesses, event initiatives and our wider Portsmouth community.
