[Hope into Action Portsmouth](#) is a charity that was started in 2017, and which aims to help churches in and around Portsmouth find a loving home for those affected by homelessness. It inspires churches to invest in houses and welcome tenants, whose lives can be transformed as a result. Churches across this area have already provided 11 houses worth more than £3m, with up to 31 tenants supported by six different congregations.
