Portsmouth Pride exists to support the LGBTQ+ community in Portsmouth and the surrounding areas.

We create spaces for the community to come together through our series of year-round events and a programme of community engagement projects, and we celebrate the diversity of our amazing city and residents at our annual flagship event which many people simply know as Portsmouth Pride.

We are inclusive of all and advocate for further protection of the rights and freedoms of LGBTQ+ people, not only in Portsmouth, but across the UK and around the world.

We work with local community action groups, schools & colleges, universities, sports clubs, local businesses, political representatives, civil bodies and individuals, as well as regional and national charities focused on progressing and protecting the rights of LGBTQ+ people.
